

**Minutes of Special City Council Meeting

The Special City Council meeting began at 8:30 A.M.

Purpose of Special City Council Meeting

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss extending the Declaration of a State of Emergency related to Hurricane Ian.

Resolution

City Attorney Sandra Robinson stated Mayor Hoffman declared a state of emergency on Monday, September 26, 2022. In order to extend the Declaration of a State of Emergency for Hurricane Ian beyond 72 hours, an affirmative vote of at least five Council members was required.

Mayor Hoffman requested the City Clerk read Resolution No. 2124-2022 by title only, whereupon Ms. Gosselin read the following:

“A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE BEACH, FLORIDA, EXTENDING THE DECLARED STATE OF EMERGENCY RELATING TO HURRICANE IAN; PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION OF RECITALS, REPEAL OF PRIOR INCONSISTENT RESOLUTIONS AND COUNCIL DECISIONS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.”

Motion: It was moved by Ms. Golding, seconded by Ms. Dumont, to adopt Resolution No. 2124-2022, extending the declared state of emergency relating to Hurricane Ian.

Discussion: *None*

Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Dumont, Golding, Meza, Stokes, Mayor Hoffman
The motion passed unanimously.

There being no further business, the Special City Council Meeting adjourned at 8:32 A.M.

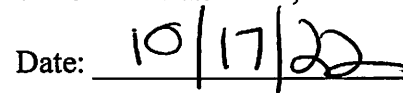
