CALL TO ORDER

This meeting was called to order at 3:02 PM.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A. November 17, 2023 Minutes

OLD BUSINESS

A. Chair and Vice-Chair Nomination

Since the last meeting, our Chair unfortunately relocated out West. Staff informed the committee they would need to nominate a Chair, and pending who the nominee was, potentially a new Vice Chair.

The committee unanimously agreed to nominate Vice Chair, Chad Labenz as the Chair. All were in favor, and Mr. Labenz accepted his new role as Chair.

Mr. Terry Deloach was nominated as the Vice Chair, all were in favor, and Mr. Deloach accepted.

NEW BUSINESS

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION

A. Review of Submittals for CAPE Mural

It was initially thought that the committee would use the platform CaFE to score and review all of the applicants, but after some discussion, the committee determined all members had issues scoring and reviewing the applications on the platform. Staff and the committee agreed to continue using the platform to accept applications, but moving forward, staff will create a

presentation of all of the eligible applicants and send to the committee for review.

The committee reviewed 31 applicants during this meeting. Of the 31, the committee initially narrowed it down to their top 5, and then narrowed down to the top 3. Staff will reach out to the 3 finalists and set up zoom interviews for the committee to interact with each artist.

B. Temporary Art Installation Ideas

Staff briefly informed the committee they would like to begin brainstorming ideas for temporary art installations.

C. Branding for Art

Staff briefly told the committee they would like to come up with some 'thing' (animal, surfboard, etc) that will be featured all throughout the art pieces downtown that will tie them all together.
