Purpose of Public Hearing

The purpose of the hearing was to invite the public to speak in favor of or against adopting two recently proposed Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act (PURPA) standards for Beaches Energy Services.

City Manager Mike Staffopoulos explained the City was required under PURPA standards to hold a public hearing any time new standards are being proposed at the federal level. There are two PURPA standards being proposed. One is related to demand response practices, and the other is related to electric vehicle charging. Mr. Staffopoulos stated this item would be brought back to the Council at the July 10, 2023, Council Briefing for a discussion of the impact of the proposed standards and any public hearing comments.

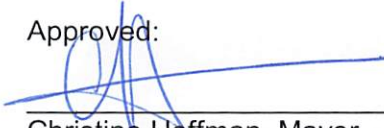
Public Hearing
