SUBJECT:	Sea Life Statue Update

BACKGROUND

The PAAC, CRA and City Council have all expressed an interest in working with local artists on art projects in the downtown CRA district. The art committee created the idea of a 'branding' project for the downtown titled "Sea Life in the City". The PAAC and staff issued a survey to the public, requesting feedback on which "sea life" the City would like to see first.

The animal with the highest percentage of votes was the Sea Turtle. Staff reached out to a local sculptor on behalf of the PAAC and CRA to gauge their interest in taking on this project with the City. The sculptor and their team are very interested in the project, but are requesting a design fee and contract be executed prior to moving forward.

Following F.S. 287.057, "Artistic Services" are not required to be a competitive bidding process. Staff will work with the appropriate departments internally, to ensure we are able to execute the agreement and move forward. Staff will then bring the agreement to the CRA, and City Council for final approval before moving forward with this project.

Staff will continue to provide updates on the status of the project.
