BACKGROUND

The Jacksonville Beach Pier is one of the most prominent and photographed landmarks in the City. The art installation at this site should be a visual gateway to the pier reflecting the character and energy of the area surrounding it, taking inspiration from the water, nearby dunes, and beach life culture. The installation will be integrated into the Pier Entry area located on the boardwalk.

The scale and structure of the installation needs to allow for good visibility for pedestrians, while maintaining enough space along the boardwalk for emergency vehicles.

This art installation will not incorporate any traditional lighting, as this site is located immediately adjacent to the beach.

Staff has attached a presentation with potential sculpture candidates for this project, who have all previously applied to COJB projects.

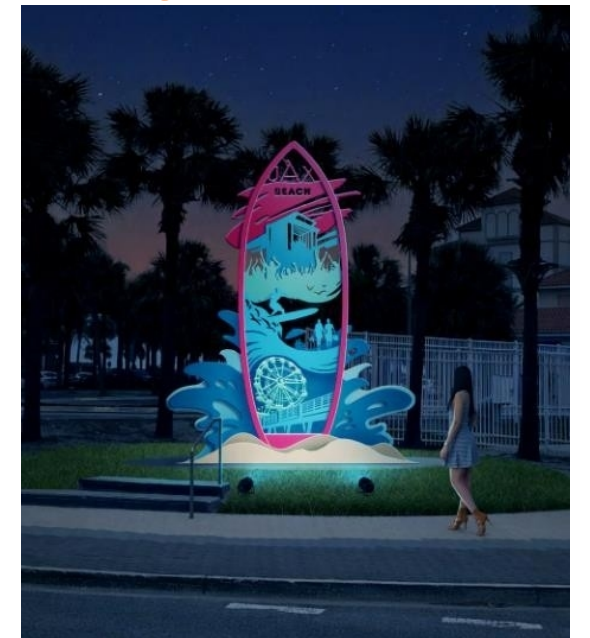

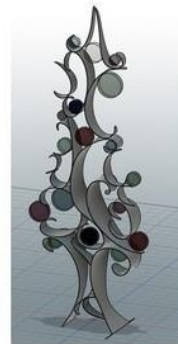

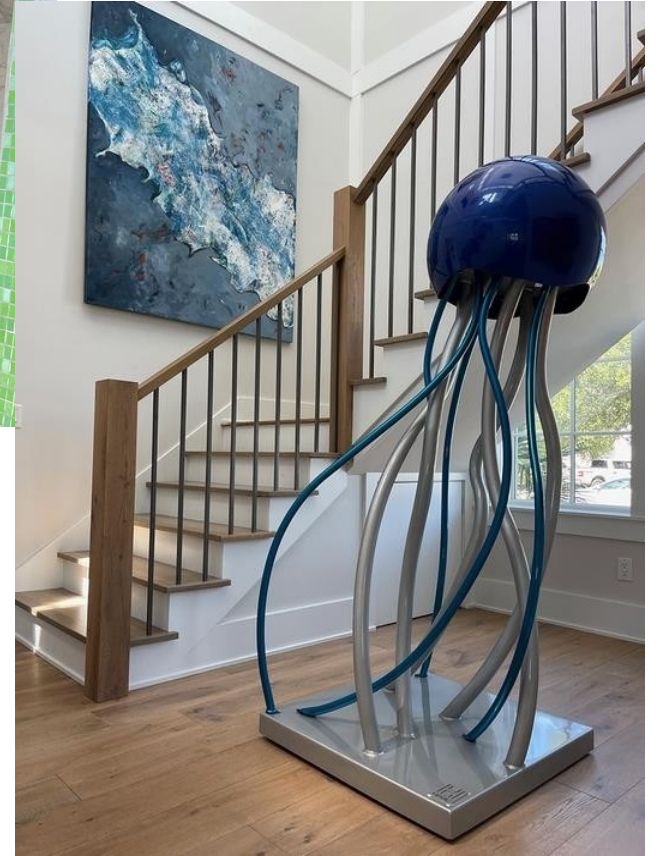
