Violations: ***LDC Sec. 32-43. - Private wastewater disposal. (a) Where a public sanitary sewer is not available under the provisions of section 32-42, the building sewer shall be connected to a private wastewater disposal system complying with the provisions of this section. No person shall construct a septic tank or other wastewater disposal facility without prior approval from the director of public works' office. The availability of sewer is defined in section 32-42 of this chapter.***
(c) No person shall construct, repair, alter or enlarge any septic tank unless he receives approval by the director of public works and shall hold a valid permit for the work issued by the health officer and a permit issued from the city.
(e) No septic tank or other subsurface disposal facility shall be installed

where a public sewer is accessible to the premises involved.
